Since July 2007, Allen Lew, Director of the Office of Public Education Facilities Modernization (OPEFM), has undertaken a \$3 billion capital improvement program to renovate and build new schools for the District of Columbia. His office has been responsible for issuing RFPs and awarding contracts for an extraordinary amount of design and construction work and related procurement – all part of the modernization program. OPEFM's efforts to create a healthy environment for students of the District of Columbia have not been without obstacles, impediments and delays.
